



2011 Street Clinic Application Form

As part of the Greenest Block in Brooklyn contest, in association with Borough President Marty Markowitz and with support from the Brooklyn Community Foundation, GreenBridge is offering a limited number of free street garden clinics to block associations and neighborhood groups. The clinics will provide on-site street tree bed gardening instruction along with a variety of other urban gardening practices best suited to your block.

Requirements:

1. Applicants must be sponsored by a block association or neighborhood organization registered in the 2011 Greenest Block in Brooklyn contest.
 2. A minimum of ten people must attend.
 3. Securing a location and the clinic and providing publicity are the responsibility of the block association or neighborhood organization.
 4. The date and time will be negotiated with GreenBridge.
 5. An application must be submitted at least three weeks before your first proposed clinic date.
 6. Please fill out the attached application, and we will contact you regarding scheduling. We are able to provide a limited number of clinics, so we must respond to requests on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Clinics can be held indoors or outdoors, but an indoor site should be secured in case of rain.
 - Print the application on the next page, fill it out, and mail it to the address listed.
